The moment of recognition

In his book 'Can you drink the cup,' Henri Nouwen says it was necessary that the easy 'yes' of the disciples of Jesus be accompanied by many other difficult 'yeses' until their cups were completely empty.

Pope Francis declared the third Sunday of Easter will be celebrated as **Sunday of the Word of God** and the story of the two disciples headed to Emmaus is used as the logo of this day. The story of the two disciples written by St. Luke, brings to mind Joseph and Mary who earlier on lost the young boy Jesus but later found him in the temple. Studying these two stories side by side, we can see the characters moving away from Jerusalem (the place of worship). We too are some miles away from our churches but not too far for Jesus to catch up with us. God likes to hear us tell Him our stories as if we were alone on the pilgrimage of life.

Sometimes we are frustrated due to our unrealistic expectations. There is a cup of joy and a cup of sorrow. We cannot choose joy and shun sorrow. We need Jesus to give us the insight to see this mystery otherwise our hearts are slow to grasping the truths of God's kingdom.

Luke mentions the name of one of the disciples (Cleopas). Some scripture scholars argue that the two disciples were a man and his wife. Going back to the Old Testament using a technique called typology, similarities can be seen according to the manner in which the eyes of Adam and Eve were opened and those of Cleopas and his companion. When Adam and Eve ate of the fruits from the forbidden tree they knew 'evil'. At the breaking of bread (fruits of the new tree), the eyes of the two disciples recognized the Saviour. They have a new understanding and can now make meaning out of the death of Jesus. Moments of recognition come to us when we allow God whisper to our burning hearts.

Dear friends in Christ, though our hearts are burning right now as we yearn to have back our lives, let us allow the Lord to open the scriptures to us every day and keep our eyes focused on the heavenly Jerusalem.
